

The Intrapreneur Edge FAQ's

Q: What does the program cost?

A: The program is free for BCIT students.

Q: Is this program open to BCIT students from all schools?

A: This program is open to ALL BCIT students from all BCIT schools. You do NOT need to be enrolled in a business program.

Q: Can BCIT graduates participate?

A: No, this program is only open to current BCIT students (part-time and full-time).

Q: Can I earn course credits for completing this program?

A: No, this is an extra-curricular activity for BCIT students focused on skill development. You cannot earn BCIT course credits for participating in this program. You will, however, upon successful completion of the program earn a micro-credential (digital badge) that you can use to showcase your intrapreneurial competencies to potential employers.

Q: What is a micro-credential?

A: A micro-credential is a representation of learning, awarded for completion of a short program that is focused on a specific set of competencies (i.e., skills, knowledge, attributes). You will receive your micro-credential in the form of a digital badge that you can use on your resume or on professional networking profiles, like LinkedIn. A: No. This program helps participants learn and practice important leadership skills, like decisionmaking, goal setting, creative problem solving, and resourcefulness.
