

## HOW IS YOUR MONEY INVESTED?

As part of your tuition, the BCIT Student Association (BCITSA) collects a fee which they use to deliver programs, services, events and governance to enhance your student life. Use this chart to better understand the many ways that BCITSA maximizes your investment, and continues to create new opportunities while strengthening existing offerings.

### Student Association Activity Fee

Career Services, Entrepreneurial Services, Student Services (Publications, Clubs, Events), Advocacy, Governance

### Capital Levy Fee

**\$8.00** /registration Co-Op - Technology

### New SA Centre Building Fee\*

**\$20.00** /term Co-Op - Technology  
**\$1.14** /week Co-Op - Trades

\*Applies to any student taking at least (1) class on the Burnaby Campus. Students not attending classes in BBY are exempt from this fee.

### Student Medical Plan

**\$228.00/year**

Students are automatically enrolled in the plan if your program is designated full-time by BCIT and lasting at least 16 weeks. Fees for the plan are also automatically included by the Institution with registration. If you are unsure about whether or not you are eligible, please visit or contact the BCITSA Health & Dental Plan Office (in building SE2). It is also mandatory for you to have basic medical coverage such as a BC Care Card (MSP/Services Card/Personal Health Number), Student Guard (Guard Me) or comparable coverage for your country or province of origin.

### U-Pass

**\$41.00 /month\***

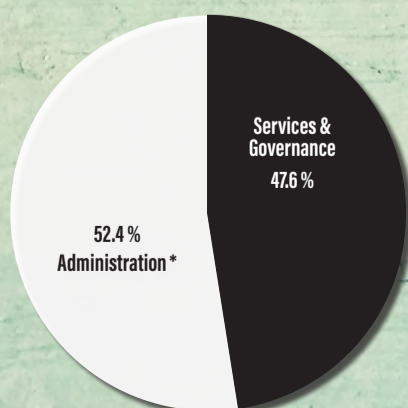
U-Pass BC is available to students who meet all of the following criteria:

- Accepted into and remain declared in eligible full-time studies programs
- Registered into courses which are delivered in Metro Vancouver
- Registered into a minimum of (3.0) credits or whose tuition exceeds \$170.00 per month of study
- Assessed a Student Association Fee

### Resource Allocation

Student Fees cover 83% of the BCITSA administrative and services expenses, as per 2017 financials. The remaining expenses are covered by revenues from other sources. What this means is that for every dollar we spend on our administration and services, we only need to collect \$0.83 in student fees.
