Summary

The Graphic Designer is responsible for providing fast, accurate, and professional graphic design services to all internal stakeholders. You assist the Creative Lead in developing and implementing a visual brand identity across multiple platforms; and the production of original graphic elements and illustrations for use in marketing projects. The Graphic Designer will report to the Director of Marketing and Communications.

Job Duties

- Provide fast, accurate, and professional graphic design services as assigned by Marketing Portfolio
- Collaborate with internal clients to understand and meet their needs
- Provide design support for digital content
- Produce illustrations, titles and other graphic elements for both online and print mediums
- Develop consistent style sheets and design templates

Education and Experience (Minimum Requirement)

- Candidate must have been registered as a full-time student in the previous academic year and have the intention to return on a full-time basis in fall.
- Candidate must be between the ages of 15-30
- Candidate must be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or have official refugee protection status under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (foreign students are not eligible) and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

- Must be returning as a full-time student in September 2019
