- **Financial Aid and Awards**- Set Reps were encouraged to apply for the Bursaries, proposed by the Financial Aid and Awards to BCIT Students.
- **BBA program** –the early deadline- at the end of this month. Students were encouraged to apply even if they didn’t make their final decision yet. It is required 72% minimum GPA. There are available two options: full-time and part-time. Students can finish their part-time program in 7 years. The part-time program is much more difficult to get in to, for the reason that a lot of students prefer this option. Students have possibility to have their BBA outside of Canada, in Germany for example for the same conditions.
