22.4.4 ATC Coverall Program

- BCIT is eliminating their Coverall program at all campuses with the exception of the ATC campus.
- Starting in September, the Coverall program will be an ATC program and ATC will be absorbing the costs of the overalls.
- All students MUST return their current coveralls to Stores by AUGUST 15TH! Failure to do so will result in charges against student accounts.
- It is uncertain if ATC will be receiving new coveralls by September. The Chair will confirm. If not, he will look into the possibility of ATC students receiving a discount voucher for Mark's Work Warehouse.

22.5 New Business:

22.5.1 ATC Student Council Representative

- Starting in September, ATC will be in need of a Council Representative.
- Each BCIT school (School of Business, School of Computing, etc.) has 1 Council Member per 350 students. ATC has 250 students and 1 Council Member.
- Meetings take place bi-monthly on Monday's from 1730-2030 (usually 1.5 hrs.) at the Burnaby Campus. Participants consist of the Student Representative body (President, VP's, Chairs) along with Council Members.
- Monetary compensation for Council Member - \$30/meeting. Dinner and drinks provided.
- Council Members vote on all matters and hold Chairs, VP's and President accountable for their actions.
- Topics of discussion: SA By-Law changes, Annual Budget, Elections, SA Direction, Approval/Disapproval of new clubs, Approval/Disapproval of construction projects across BCIT.
- The Chair has offered to transport the Council Representative from ATC to Burnaby Campus at 1630. He will also drive them home if Council Representative lives close to the Burnaby Campus or transport them to nearest sky train station.
- The Chair has submitted a request to the Student Council to obtain compensation for travel costs from ATC to Burnaby campus. The Student Council will need to approve this request.

- BCIT has cancelled the EASA program.
- EASA was an opportunity for students to work towards the European AME M/E license.
- The Student Association in collaboration with Maximum Altitude has developed a questionnaire to determine what the student body wants to do about this matter.
