1. Education – Student Evaluation Policy 5103
Be aware of how much can final exams can contribute to your final grade
Midterms are not allowed to be your final exam
50% of your mark can be the final exam
Evaluation criteria: clearly indicated that you will be graded subjectively ex. Participation grade
If tis 20%, it should be followed with an outline of how you are graded and they need to be on your course outline.
Fail to perform, instructors fill out a student performance report, they will meet with you to discuss the report. Students are expected to sign it, acknowledging it was taken into consideration and the instructors gave support. Students do not have to follow the report.
This is confidential – instructor and program head only.
2. Education – Course Outline
If there isn't a course Outline, all courses must have them.
Let advocates know if there an Outline.

Assignments and rubrics should be provided by your instructors.

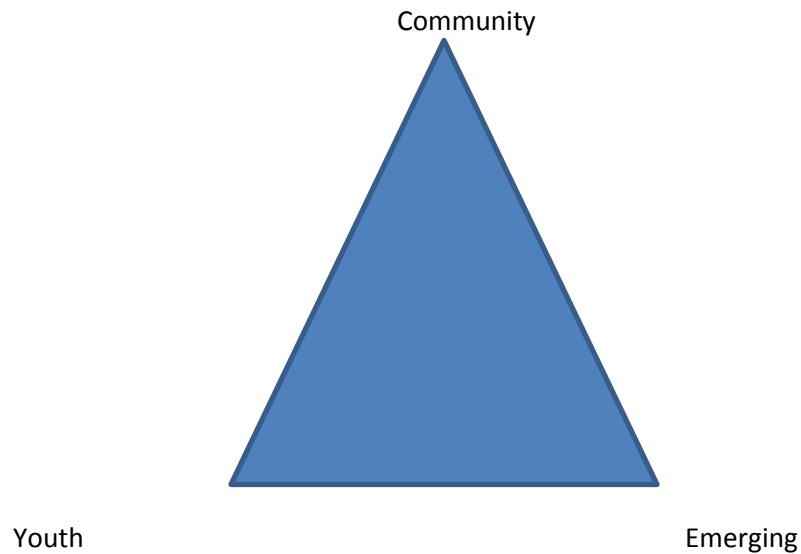
