SUMMARY

Each BCITSA Appeals Committee, comprised of three students at large, is appointed to hear any appeals for a given SA election or by-election. Through these roles, the committee members learn more about BCITSA governance, the administration of elections, and the application of due process, written rules, and precedent from similar cases.

JOB DUTIES

Committee Training & Preparedness

- Upon appointment, the Committee members shall receive relevant training in matters of due process, fairness, natural justice, and applicable rules and precedents
- Often, Committee members may be advised on very short notice that somebody has filed an appeal of a decision of the Elections Committee

Deciding Appeals

- The Committee invites both sides, the Elections Committee & the appellant, to present their arguments and to answer any Appeals Committee questions
- Understand and apply any applicable Bylaws, Regulations, and policies
- Meet in private, with a member of Advocacy staff, and reach a decision in a timely manner
