

Set Rep Information Handout

For Faculty

Overview

The Set Rep Program is a chance for students to grow as leaders and help build a connected, supportive community at BCIT.

Set Reps play a key role within their set. They help classmates stay informed, build connections, and promote a supportive, inclusive learning environment. They also represent their set to the Student Association and advocate for student needs.

How to Elect a Set Rep

- Provide an overview of the role.
- 2. Ask for volunteers or nominations.
- 3. The candidates introduce themselves and share why they should be the Set Rep.
- 4. The set votes through a show of hands or a secret ballot.
- 5. The elected Set Rep registers on the **BCITSA** website.

Alternatively, you can invite a Student Association representative to conduct a 5-minute Set Rep election. Set Reps should be elected (or re-elected) at the start of each academic term or year.

Best Practices

- Each set should have one Set Rep, but can have two if the Set Reps agree to share the role.
- A student may serve as Set Rep for multiple terms or years, though we recommend holding Set Rep elections within the first 2-3 weeks of every new academic term or year.
- All Set Reps must register online with the Student Association to receive meeting notices and updates. They must re-register each term to remain on the active Set Rep list.
