The Set Rep Program is a chance for students to grow as leaders and help build a connected, supportive community at BCIT.

Set Reps play a key role within their set. They help classmates stay informed, build connections, and promote a supportive, inclusive learning environment. They also represent their set to the Student Association and advocate for student needs. It's a meaningful way to make a difference at BCIT.

## What does a Set Rep do?

### ➤ **Build Community**

Set Reps help classmates feel connected. They might start a group chat, plan a study session, or just check in with a classmate who seems overwhelmed.

### ➤ **Support Peers**

Set Reps are the go-to people for classmates who need help. They support their peers by listening, sharing resources, offering advice, and encouraging them to speak up for themselves.

### ➤ **Keep Classmates Informed**

Set Reps keep classmates in the loop about important updates, events, tests, and services from the Student Association and BCIT.

### ➤ **Represent Student Voices**

Set Reps listen to their classmates' concerns and ideas, then share that feedback with the Student Association. They help ensure student voices are heard and valued by BCIT.

### ➤ **Attend Meetings**

Each school hosts two Set Rep meetings per term. These relaxed gatherings are a chance to connect, share ideas, and learn new ways to support your set.

*A great Set Rep is friendly, reliable, and a good listener. You don't need to have all the answers; you just need to care about your classmates and want to help them be the best they can be.*

## What does a Set Rep get?

As a Set Rep, you'll build skills in leadership, communication, and problem-solving — all of which are valuable in school, work, and everyday life. You'll also learn how to bring people together, navigate group dynamics, and build a stronger sense of community.

Set Reps who go above and beyond may be recognized with the *Distinguished Set Rep Award* — a \$500 prize awarded annually to one outstanding Set Rep from each school.
