

Construction Leadership Award by Axiom Builders APPLICATION INFORMATION

The Construction Leadership Award by Axiom Builders recognizes a student in the School of Construction and the Environment who has demonstrated strong leadership both in the classroom and through extracurricular involvement.

This award celebrates a student who embodies Axiom Builders' core values of Humility, Autonomy, Respect, Accountability, and Excellence, and who contributes positively to the BCIT community.

Award Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a registered BCIT student in the School of Construction and the Environment.
- Demonstrate strong leadership in the classroom, such as contributing positively to group work, supporting peers, showing initiative, or helping foster a collaborative learning environment.
- Show meaningful commitment to extracurricular activities, which may include student leadership roles, volunteer work, industry involvement, or other contributions beyond academic requirements.
- Demonstrate how you embody one or more of Axiom Builders' core values — Humility, Autonomy, Respect, Accountability, and Excellence — through your actions, decisions, and contributions to the BCIT community.

Application Requirements

To apply for this award, you will need to submit the following:

1. Completed Online Application Form

Fill out all required fields before the deadline posted on our website.

2. Personal Statement (approximately one page)

In your statement, explain how you meet the eligibility criteria and why you are a strong candidate for this award. Your personal statement must be uploaded as a PDF or Word document when completing the [online application form](#).

3. Two Letters of Recommendation (submitted by your nominators)

You must be nominated by two members of the BCIT community:

- One current BCIT student
- One BCITSA staff member or BCIT faculty/staff member

Each nominator must complete the [online nomination form](#) and submit their letter of recommendation directly via the form.

Application Process

1. Review the eligibility criteria.
2. Write your personal statement.
3. Ask one student and one BCIT/BCITSA staff or faculty member to nominate you.
4. Ensure both nominators complete and submit the online nomination form before the application deadline. *Important: You do not need to collect the letters of recommendation yourself. They will be submitted directly through the nomination form. However, it is your responsibility to ensure your nominators submit their forms on time.*
5. Complete and submit your online application form, including uploading your personal statement, before the deadline stated on our [website](#).
