

Overview

The Set Rep program is the common entry point of the leadership pipeline at the Student Association. It provides students with meaningful opportunities to demonstrate leadership, build their soft skills, and improve the quality of student life.

Set Reps are classroom leaders who support the success of their classmates. They keep their set organized, empowered and connected, and they liaise with instructors and the Student Association to professionally provide feedback from the set.

What does a Set Rep do?

➤ **Build Community**

Set Reps help classmates connect with each other and student life. This might look like starting a set group chat, inviting classmates to upcoming campus events, or scheduling regular study sessions.

➤ **Know the Available Services**

When classmates need help, Set Reps connect them with the best support service. Set Reps aren't tutors or therapists, they're a bridge to professional support networks like the BCIT Student Life Office or the Student Association's Advocacy Office. When in doubt, ask an [Advocate](#).

➤ **Professionally Represent Student Voices**

Set Reps hear student feedback directly from students. When appropriate, this feedback should be professionally communicated to the Chair at a Set Rep meeting or privately to the instructor.

➤ **Lead By Example**

Set Reps model professionalism to set an example for their classmates to emulate. They arrive at classes on time, build strong relationships with instructors, and treat others with respect.

➤ **Attend Meetings**

The Chair of each School holds regular Set Rep meetings during the academic year. These casual gatherings allow Set Reps to connect with each other, share best practices, and voice student feedback directly to representatives of the Student Association. Plus, there's always plenty of pizza!

What does a Set Rep get?

Set Reps build their skills in leadership, communication, and problem-solving through experience. By taking responsibility for improving the student experience, they are also building a stronger student community for themselves and their peers. What Set Reps put into their set and community, they get back tenfold.

When Set Reps go above and beyond can be nominated for the *Distinguished Set Rep Award*. This \$750 prize is presented annually to the most outstanding Set Rep from each School and specialty campus.

How to Get Involved
