Sun Run

As part of an initiative taken on by the Chair of the School of Energy, BCIT and Student Association are collaborating to sponsor students to participate in the annual Sun Run 10km race free of cost. The Dean of the School of Construction and the Environment has pledged \$500 and Student Association has matched that to sponsor approximately 10 students from the School of Construction and the Environment to participate. Registration will be on a first come, first serve basis. The Sun Run will take place on Sunday, April 19th in Vancouver. Increased MSP Prescription

Full-time students pay a fee each semester to be covered under BCIT's medical services, unless they manually opted out of this service. The Chair of Health Sciences has determined that there

is a gap in the prescriptions that are covered under our current plan. The VP of Finance and Chair of Health Sciences consulted BCIT's Health Services, to seek their recommendation on which prescription additions would be of most value to students. It was determined that the following drugs are the most prescribed/most in demand and therefore a priority.

- Gardasil
 - Health Services asserts that while Gardasil is covered for certain young people up to age 26, this is only provided for specific conditions (*only if male, HIV positive, etc.*), so they feel that this is a priority to add to the plan.
- Trumenba and Nimenrix:
 - Meningitis vaccines are recommended for med lab students in School of Health Sciences, and it was indicated that currently there are a large portion of students opting not to receive these vaccinations due to cost.
- Wellbutrin, Bupropion, and Cymbalta:
 - These are commonly prescribed by the doctors at our school.
- Adderall, Vyvanse, Biphentin, Concerta, and Foquest:
 - These ADHD medications are the most preferred and most commonly prescribed at our health services.
- Biacna, Tactua, and Clindoxyl:
 - These derma care medications are commonly prescribed at BCIT.

As of March 1, 2020, these will all be fully covered under the MyBenefits plan. In order to use your benefits package, you must first request your MyBenefits card which can be done at <https://www.mystudentplan.ca/bcit/en/form-benefits-card-registration>. Please note that all students must first register for a BC Fair Pharmacare, which can be done at <https://my.gov.bc.ca/fpcare/registration/requirements>.

New Student Building

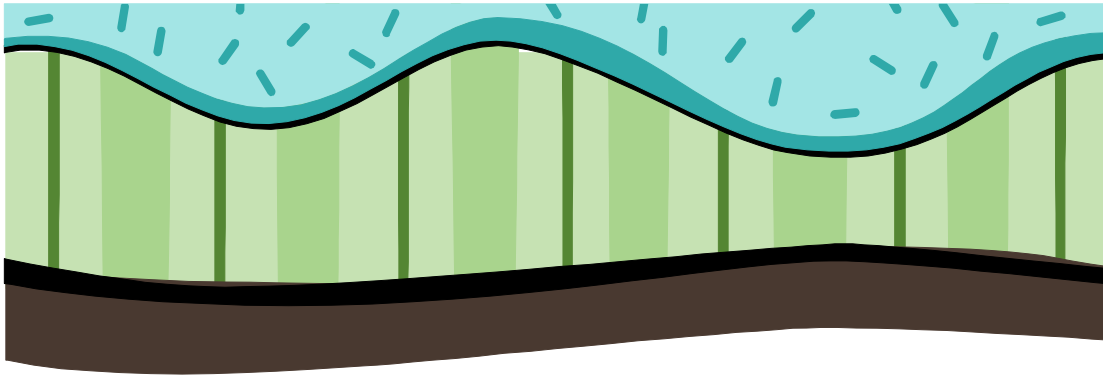

Feedback/Requests & Issues (Open Forum)

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- Learning Hub technical issues – *unsure, maybe talk to IT?*
- Too many staff parking at NE1 parking lot → Students are parking across the street – *Brin will email parking guy*
- Many students getting tickets for parking double Evos – possible sign? – *maybe submit request to Evo?*
